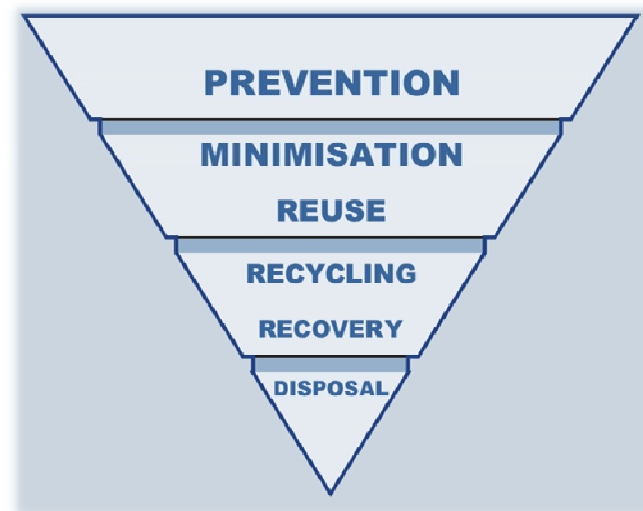

Waste Transfer Stations

- Banbury, Cheltenham, Oxford, Reading, Slough and Leatherhead
- Receive recyclables & residual waste from collection points
- Local processing and/or bunkering for trans-shipment

Materials Recovery Facilities ('MuRFs')

- 3 plants, Reading, Slough and Leatherhead
- Separate mixed recyclables into component materials
- Bulk shipment to reprocessors (reduced vehicle movements)

Energy from Waste Facility (EfW)

- Colnbrook, near Slough
- Diversion of non-recyclable waste from landfill
- Cheaper option - no landfill tax payable
- Exports 34 MW of electricity to the National Grid.

Waste management planning

- Make realistic estimate of visitors to gauge waste volume
- Consider waste types likely to arise, and how to minimise
- How much space available for bins?
- Contractors typically use HGVs, so plan access routes accordingly. Will they be subject to restricted opening hours or peak time congestion?
- Will collections be needed over a weekend?

Waste management planning

- Will your event generate unusual wastes, e.g. animal dung or spilt aviation fuel? can your normal contractor handle this?
- Have an operational contact easily accessible throughout the event, including 'after hours'. Contractors can alert you to potential difficulties before they arise and work with you to prevent them developing into problems
- Involve waste contractor early in your planning!
